

Applications invited for HK Cultural Centre live photography service stalls

A new round of applications to operate photography service stalls at the Piazza of the Hong Kong Cultural Centre (HKCC) is now open. The stalls provide live photography services for the general public and tourists. Professional photographers are invited to submit applications.

The contract period for the live photography service stalls will run from January 3 to December 30 next year. There will be four stall sites for eight photography stall operators to operate on alternate days. Operators must provide services for at least two consecutive hours between 10.30am and 10.30pm on each operating day. Successful applicants are required to personally manage the stalls in accordance with the operational requirements and pay a non-refundable registration fee of \$3,132.

All applicants are required to conduct photo demonstrations at the HKCC on a designated date and provide photos for assessment by a vetting panel of the Leisure and Cultural Services Department. If the number of qualified applications exceeds the available number of stalls, selection will be made by drawing lots. Please refer to the application form for details on operational arrangements and application.
