

Appointments to Consumer Goods Safety Appeal Board Panel announced

The Government announced today (October 11) the appointments and re-appointments to the Consumer Goods Safety Appeal Board Panel for a term of two years with effect from October 20, 2019.

Members of the Panel will form the Appeal Board, which is responsible for hearing appeals against enforcement decisions or actions taken by the

Commissioner of Customs and Excise under the Consumer Goods Safety Ordinance. When appointed, the Appeal Board shall consist of the Chairman or the Deputy Chairman of the Panel, who shall be the chairman of the Appeal Board, and one member from each of the member categories of the Panel.
