

Appointments to Human Resources Planning Commission

The Government today (January 10) announced the appointments of two new non-official members to the Human Resources Planning Commission (HRPC), Mr Kenneth Chan Yin and Mr Lui Ho-yin, for a term from January 15 to December 31, 2024.

The Chief Secretary for Administration and Chairman of the HRPC, Mr Chan Kwok-ki, welcomed the two new members.
