

Appointments to Small and Medium Enterprises Committee

The Government today (December 27) announced appointments to the new term of the Small and Medium Enterprises Committee (SMEC) for a period of two years with effect from January 1, 2025.

The SMEC comprises 27 members in the new term, with Mr Emil Yu Chen-on as the Chairman. Other non-official members mainly come from different trade, industry and professional sectors as well as small and medium enterprise (SME) practitioners.

The Secretary for Commerce and Economic Development, Mr Algernon Yau, thanked the new Chairman and members for accepting the appointments. Mr Yau said, "SMEs are the backbone of Hong Kong's economy. Over the years, the SMEC has provided a lot of constructive advice to the Government, and made significant contributions in supporting the development of SMEs. I am confident that the SMEC, under the chairmanship of Mr Yu, will continue to offer valuable advice and suggestions, and assist the Government in formulating policies conducive to the development of SMEs, further bolstering Hong Kong's economy."
