Sakharov prize

President David Sassoli will present the <u>2020 Sakharov Prize</u> for Freedom of Thought to the democratic opposition in Belarus represented by several laureates, including opposition leader Sviatlana Tsikhanouskaya, during a ceremony on Wednesday.

EU summit

Also on Wednesday, MEPs will discuss the results of the <u>EU summit on 10-11</u> <u>Decembert</u> with European Commission President Ursula von der Leyen and European Council President Charles Michel. The main topics on the agenda were the EU's long-term budget, the recovery package, the Covid-19 vaccine and measures as well as the 2030 target to combat climate change.

EU's long-term budget

After EU leaders reached an agreement at the summit on the EU's long-term budget and recovery package as well as the link to the rule of law, Parliament is ready to apply a fast track procedure to allow a vote on the final package as well as on the EU's 2021 budget during December's plenary

session. That would ensure EU support for people and businesses from the start of next year.

Covid-19

On Wednesday, MEPs will discuss an EU strategy to ensure the <u>fair</u> <u>distribution of vaccines</u>. They are also expected to approve the €47.5 billion <u>React-EU package</u> to help governments mitigate the effects of the Covid-19 crisis across the EU and support jobs, businesses, healthcare and struggling sectors such as tourism and culture.
