<u>Article - Plenary highlights: Covid-19</u> <u>recovery, vaccines, circular economy</u>



Covid recovery

On Tuesday, <u>MEPs approved the Recovery and Resilience Facility</u>, designed to help EU countries <u>recover from the Covid-19 pandemic</u>.

The impact of Covid-19 on young people and sport

MEPs called on the Commission and EU countries to do more to prevent the <u>pandemic affecting young people and the sports sector</u> in a report adopted on Wednesday.

Vaccinations

In a debate on Wednesday, MEPs said the EU should take measures to boost the <u>production of vaccines</u>.

Relief measures for aviation sector

To support the transport sector during the coronavirus crisis, MEPs agreed to extend <u>rules for the use of airport slots</u> to prevent empty flights and prolonged the validity of some licences used in the transport sector on Wednesday.

Circular Economy Action Plan

The Parliament called for tighter recycling rules and <u>binding 2030 targets</u> for materials use and <u>consumption</u> in a resolution adopted on 9 February 2021. The report represents Parliament feels should be included in the European Commission's proposed Circular Economy Action Plan to <u>achieve a circular economy by 2050</u>.

Reducing inequalities

On Tuesday, MEPs called for a minimum wage, equal labour conditions for platform workers and a better work-life balance in order to <u>fight inequality</u> and <u>in-work poverty</u>.

Human trafficking

In a report adopted on Tuesday, MEPs called on the EU to <u>step up the fight</u> <u>against human trafficking</u> and strengthen protection for victims.

Social media and democracy debate

On Wednesday, MEPs called on the EU to <u>regulate social media</u> to protect freedom of expression while limiting harmful content.

Russia

On Tuesday, MEPs hit out at the Council for failing to adequately react to <u>Russia's aggressive policies</u> and criticised EU foreign policy chief Josep Borrell for his recent visit to Moscow.

Myanmar

On Thursday MEPs called for <u>democracy in Myanmar to be restored</u> and demanded the unconditional release of all those illegally arrested followed Sunday's military coup.

Abortion ban in Poland

In a debate on Tuesday morning, MEPs condemned the rollback on abortion rights in Poland following the entry into force of the Constitutional Tribunal's ruling.
