## <u>Assessment Committee for the Funding</u> <u>Scheme to Support Transitional Housing</u> <u>Projects by Non-government</u> <u>Organisations convenes 10th meeting</u>

The 10th meeting of the Assessment Committee for the Funding Scheme to Support Transitional Housing Projects by Non-government Organisations, chaired by the Under Secretary for Transport and Housing, Dr Raymond So Waiman, was convened via video conferencing this morning (December 29).

The Assessment Committee agreed to subsidise the following transitional housing projects:

(i) Transitional housing development at Area 1B2, Muk On Street, Kai Tak, by Tung Wah Group of Hospitals. With total funding of \$262.9 million, it is expected to provide about 478 units.

(ii) Transitional housing development at vacant residential flats at 11-19Peace Avenue and 22-24 Victory Avenue, Ho Man Tin, and 72 Peel Street,Central, by Lok Kwan Social Service. With total funding of \$17.2 million, it is expected to provide about 86 units.
