

Assistance provided to Hong Kong residents in traffic accident in Shaoguan, Guangdong Province

The Hong Kong Economic and Trade Office in Guangdong (GDET0) of the Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region received on December 25 evening report of a traffic accident that occurred in Shaoguan, Guangdong Province in that afternoon. The accident resulted in the death of a Hong Kong resident and two other Hong Kong residents were injured. The three Hong Kong residents were passengers on board a Mainland licensed private car when the accident happened. Upon learning of the incident, the GDET0 deployed officers to Shaoguan to render assistance to the residents and their families on the spot.

The GDET0 and the Hong Kong Immigration Department (ImmD) will continue to closely liaise with the residents concerned and their families to render all practicable assistance.
