At least 21 killed, several others hurt in Gaza Strip fire

GAZA: At least 21 people were killed and several others injured when a fire broke out in a building where residents attended a party in the Gaza Strip, health and civil emergency officials said on Thursday.

It took fire fighters more than an hour to get control of the massive flames that burst through the top floor of a four-story residential building in the densely-populated Jabalia refugee camp in northern Gaza Strip.

Six killed, 16 injured after gas explosion in Sulaymaniyah, Iraqi Kurdistan

LONDON: Six people were killed, 16 injured, and three buildings were

destroyed after a liquefied petroleum gas system exploded in Sulaymaniyah, Iraqi Kurdistan, the Iraqi News Agency reported.

"More than 20 people were present in the house in which the accident occurred, eight people were taken to hospital, and there are currently between 10-12 people, including children, under the rubble," an eyewitness said.

Sulaymaniyah's Civil Defense said 10 teams are working to rescue those trapped under the rubble of the buildings.
