


Moroccan police seize two million captagon pills at northern port

RABAT: Moroccan authorities Friday seized more than two million amphetaminetype captagon pills, foiling an "international trafficking attempt" to West Africa, police said.

The pills were found at the Tanger Med industrial port complex on the kingdom's northern coast, the DGSN security service said in a statement. The drugs were "concealed inside a goods container onboard a maritime transport ship" headed from Lebanon to West Africa, it added, without specifying which country.
