REPORT FOR THE WEST END WARD - WEEK COMMENCING MONDAY 26 SEPTEMBER 2022

Miller's Wynd — closed until 26 December 2022 at its junction with Hawkhill for major construction works.

City Road (Tullideph Place to Logie Street) — closed for up to 3 weeks for Scottish Water emergency works.

Polepark Road — closed from its junction with Lochee Road to its junction with Milnbank Road (in a southerly direction only) for footway resurfacing works commencing Tuesday 20 September for 2 weeks.

Blackness Road (at Jedburgh Road) — temporary traffic lights for one week for Scottish Water work.

Hillside Road (junction with Hillside Place) — closed from Monday 26 September or Tuesday 27 September for 3 days for carriageway resurfacing works. (We are seeking clarification on the start date).

Forthcoming Roadworks
