REPORT FOR WEST END WARD – WEEK COMMENCING MONDAY 20 JUNE 2022

West Marketgait (Hawkhill to Ward Road) – northbound nearside lane closure on Monday 20 June for Scottish Water ironwork repairs.

Forthcoming Roadworks

South Tay Street – temporary traffic lights from Monday 27 June for 4 weeks for footway works.

Miller's Wynd – closed at its junction with Hawkhill for major construction works. Start date Monday 27 June for 6 months

Minto Place (west leg) – closed from Monday 11 July for 5 days for

carriageway resurfacing works.

Pennycook Lane – closed from Wednesday 20 July for 3 days for carriageway resurfacing works.

Ninewells Avenue – closed from Monday 25 July for 10 days for carriageway resurfacing works.

South Tay Street – temporary traffic lights from Monday 8 August for 2 weeks for footway works.
