## CFS urges public not to consume a kind of prepackaged cocktail sausage rolls with incorrect use-by date

The Centre for Food Safety (CFS) of the Food and Environmental Hygiene Department today (October 29) urged the public not to consume a kind of prepackaged cocktail sausage rolls imported from the United Kingdom (UK) because the product concerned was found with an incorrect use-by date. The trade should also stop using or selling the affected product immediately should they possess it.

Details of the product are as follows:

Product name: 20 Cocktail Sausage Rolls

Brand: M&S

Place of origin: UK Net weight: 296 grams

Importer: ALF Retail Hong Kong Limited

Use-by date: January 10, 2022

"The CFS, through its Food Incident Surveillance System, noted a notice issued by the Food Standards Agency of the UK that the above-mentioned product is under recall because it was found with an incorrect use-by date," a spokesman for the CFS said.

Upon learning of the incident, the CFS immediately followed up with major local importers and retailers. A preliminary investigation confirmed that the affected product has been imported by the above-mentioned sole importer. For the sake of prudence, the importer has voluntarily stopped sales and removed from shelves the affected product and initiated a recall. The CFS will alert the trade, continue to follow up on the incident and take appropriate action. An investigation is ongoing.
