

Commission consults Member States on new child rights strategy

The group seeks to support preparations for the new comprehensive EU child rights strategy that the European Commission plans to be adopted during the first quarter 2021.

The meeting aimed at sharing the ideas and content of the six pillars of the strategy with government officials. It explored how Member States can help deliver on the strategy including at the local level.
