Construction of seawater intakes and outfalls for seawater district cooling system in Tseung Kwan O Industrial Estate proposed

The Government has proposed to allow the Hong Kong Science and Technology Parks Corporation to construct seawater intakes and outfalls in Tseung Kwan 0 to support the seawater district cooling system in Tseung Kwan 0 Industrial Estate. The extent of the area of foreshore and seabed affected is described in a notice published in the <u>Government Gazette</u> today (November 8).

The proposed works include the construction of a pair of seawater intakes and a pair of seawater outfalls and reconstruction of two sections of an existing seawall within an area of approximately 2 120 square metres of foreshore and seabed. The proposed works are scheduled to commence in the first quarter of 2020 for completion in 2021.

The notice and its related plan are posted near the site. The plan is also available for inspection at:

Any person who considers that he or she has an interest, right or easement in or over the foreshore and seabed involved may submit a written objection to the Director of Lands, 20/F, North Point Government Offices, 333 Java Road, North Point, Hong Kong, within two months from the above-mentioned date, i.e. on or before January 8, 2020. The notice of such objection shall describe the interest, right or easement of the objector and the manner in which he or she will be allegedly affected.
