

# COVID-19 Vaccination Programme statistics

The COVID-19 Vaccination Programme has been implemented for 182 days since February 26, 2021.

So far, about 7 287 800 doses of vaccines have been administered under the Vaccination Programme. Details are as follows:

In the 24 hours ending at 8pm today (August 26), about 60 500 persons have received vaccination and about 10 500 new vaccination bookings have been made online. Details are as follows:

In the 24 hours ending at 0.00am today, there were 14 cases of ambulance transfer to hospital from CVCs. They were sent to hospital after experiencing common side effects after vaccination and were in stable condition. Nine of them were discharged, one person was admitted for observation, three persons were discharged against medical advice and one person left hospital without seeking any consultation.
