## COVID-19 Vaccination Programme statistics

The COVID-19 Vaccination Programme has been implemented for 195 days since February 26, 2021.

So far, about 7 967 500 doses of vaccines have been administered under the Vaccination Programme. Details are as follows:

In the 24 hours ending at 8pm today (September 8), about 39 900 persons have received vaccination and about 8 000 new vaccination bookings have been made online. Details are as follows:

In the 24 hours ending at 0.00am today, there were nine cases of ambulance transfer to hospital from CVCs or designated general out-patient clinics of the Hospital Authority. They were sent to hospital after experiencing common side effects after vaccination and were in stable condition. Eight of them were discharged, and one person was discharged against medical advice.
