

COVID-19 Vaccination Programme statistics

The COVID-19 Vaccination Programme has been implemented for 248 days since February 26, 2021.

So far, about 9 043 000 doses of vaccines have been administered under the Vaccination Programme. Details are as follows:

| | Number of persons receiving Sinovac vaccine | Number of persons receiving BioNTech vaccine | Total number of doses |

In the 24 hours ending at 8pm today (October 31), about 6 300 persons have received vaccination. Details are as follows:

| | Sinovac vaccine | BioNTech vaccine |

| Number of persons receiving first dose | 800 | 1 900 |
| Number of persons receiving second dose | 1 300 | 2 300 |
| Overall percentage of persons receiving vaccines at Community Vaccination Centres (CVCs) | 93% | 84% |

In the 24 hours ending at 0.00am today, there was one case of ambulance transfer to hospital from a CVC. The person was sent to hospital after experiencing common side effects after vaccination and was in stable condition. The person was admitted for observation.
