DCS to visit Guangzhou and Macao

In the afternoon, he will go to Macao to attend the Welcome Banquet of the Business Conference on Guangdong-Hong Kong-Macao Greater Bay Area Development. He will return to Hong Kong on the same evening.

During Mr Sun's absence, the Under Secretary for Labour and Welfare, Mr Ho Kai-ming, will be the Acting Secretary for Labour and Welfare.
