## <u>Debbie Abrahams responds to Government</u> <u>announcement not to appeal High Court</u> <u>PIP judgement</u>

"The Government was wrong to bring in the PIP regulations last year and it was wrong to ignore time and time again the views of the courts.

"Serious questions remain including; how many people have been adversely affected by the Government's reckless decision to oppose the tribunal's original judgment? "This is yet more evidence of the duplicity and disarray of the Tories' social security policies."
