<u>Electoral Affairs Commission Report on</u> 2021 Legislative Council General Election published

The Electoral Affairs Commission (EAC) Report on the 2021 Legislative Council General Election (LCGE) was published today (April 12).

The report describes how the EAC conducted and supervised the election, and sets out the detailed arrangements and relevant follow-up actions for the election. The report also contains a review of relevant electoral arrangements in the light of experience, and improvement measures for future elections.

"We are grateful to the EAC for ensuring that the election was conducted in accordance with the law and was open, transparent and efficient, and for reviewing the electoral arrangements. The Government will continue to work closely with the EAC to follow up on the recommendations contained in the report," a Government spokesman said.

In accordance with the requirements of the Electoral Affairs Commission Ordinance (Cap. 541), the EAC submitted the report on the 2021 LCGE to the Chief Executive on March 18, 2022. In line with past practice and the principle of open and transparent elections, the Government agreed with the EAC's recommendation that the report should be made public.
