

## Enterprise participates in outreach COVID-19 vaccination (with photos)

The Secretary for the Civil Service, Mr Patrick Nip, visited Manulife Tower in Kwun Tong today (July 13). During the visit, he and the Chief Executive Officer of Manulife Hong Kong, Mr Damien Green, jointly viewed the administering of the BioNTech vaccine to about 380 staff members and agents of the enterprise, as arranged by the Government's outreach vaccination service.

"I am grateful to Manulife Hong Kong for joining hands with the Government in promoting the Early Vaccination for All campaign and encouraging its employees to support the vaccination programme.

"For front-line salespersons it is very important to get vaccinated as they often have face-to-face interaction with their clients when promoting their insurance products, Mandatory Provident Fund products or investment funds.
