

Guidance: Bird flu: rules on meat produced from poultry and farmed game birds originating in disease control zones

Rules food businesses should follow for any meat produced from poultry or farmed game birds originating within a disease control zone.

Statutory guidance: Bird flu: licence to move poultry meat from poultry originating in a protection zone (EXD249 (HPAI) (EW))

You should use this licence to move poultry meat from poultry originating in a protection zone.

Statutory guidance: Bird flu: licence to remove the meat mark applied to certain poultry meat (EXD264 (HPAI) (EW))

You should use this licence if you need to remove the meat mark applied to certain poultry meat.

Statutory guidance: Bird flu: poultry meat from a protection zone identification mark

Mark which must be used to identify poultry meat from a protection zone.

Statutory guidance: Bird flu: licence to move table eggs from a premises in a free area to an egg processing plant in a protection or surveillance zone (EXD541 (HPAI) GB)

You should use this licence to move table eggs from a premises in a free area to an egg processing plant in a protection zone or surveillance zone.
