Guidance: Generating low-carbon electricity if there's no Brexit deal

- guarantees of origin of electricity produced from high-efficiency cogeneration
 - the Renewable Energy Guarantees of Origin (REGO) scheme
 - recognition of certification of installers of certain microgeneration technologies

Guidance: Manufacturing and marketing fertilisers if there's no Brexit deal

If the UK leaves the EU in March 2019 without a deal, find out how this would affect businesses that manufacture or market fertilisers.

Guidance: Regulating chemicals (REACH) if there's no Brexit deal

If the UK leaves the EU in March 2019 without a deal, find out how this would affect businesses producing, registering, importing or exporting chemicals. This includes a range of controls including labelling and packaging.

Guidance: Exporting animals and animal products if there's no Brexit deal

If the UK leaves the EU in March 2019 without a deal, find out how this would affect businesses or individuals that export animals or animal products to EU countries.
