<u>Guidance: Civil nuclear regulation if</u> there's no Brexit deal

If the UK leaves the EU in March 2019 without a deal, find out how this would affect:

- nuclear safeguards
- ownership and movement of nuclear material, equipment and technology
- management of spent fuel and radioactive waste
- reporting and notifications to the European Commission.

<u>Guidance: Farm payments if there's no</u> Brexit deal

If the UK leaves the EU in March 2019 without a deal, find out how this would affect farmers who receive payments under the EU's Common Agricultural Policy (CAP) schemes. These include payments under the Basic Payment Scheme.

<u>Guidance: Receiving rural development</u> <u>funding if there's no Brexit deal</u>

If the UK leaves the EU in March 2019 without a deal, find out how this would affect farmers, land managers, rural businesses and others across the UK who receive payments under the EU Rural Development Programmes.

<u>Guidance: Developing genetically</u> <u>modified organisms (GMOs) if there's</u>

no Brexit deal

If the UK leaves the EU in March 2019 without a deal, find out how this would affect controls on the release into the environment of genetically modified organisms (GMOs).

<u>Guidance: Producing and processing</u> <u>organic food if there's no Brexit deal</u>

If the UK leaves the EU in March 2019 without a deal, find out how this would affect anyone who grows, processes, imports or exports products labelled as organic. This applies to products including food, animal feed, livestock (including bees and farmed fish) marketed as "organic".
