<u>Guidance: Producing and processing</u> organic food if there's no Brexit deal

If the UK leaves the EU in March 2019 without a deal, find out how this would affect anyone who grows, processes, imports or exports products labelled as organic. This applies to products including food, animal feed, livestock (including bees and farmed fish) marketed as "organic".

<u>Guidance: Civil nuclear regulation if</u> <u>there's no Brexit deal</u>

If the UK leaves the EU in March 2019 without a deal, find out how this would affect:

- nuclear safeguards
- ownership and movement of nuclear material, equipment and technology
- management of spent fuel and radioactive waste
- reporting and notifications to the European Commission.

<u>Guidance: Farm payments if there's no</u> <u>Brexit deal</u>

If the UK leaves the EU in March 2019 without a deal, find out how this would affect farmers who receive payments under the EU's Common Agricultural Policy (CAP) schemes. These include payments under the Basic Payment Scheme.

<u>Guidance: Nuclear research if there's</u> <u>no Brexit deal</u>

If the UK leaves the EU in March 2019 without a deal, find out how this would

affect the UK's participation in the Euratom (the European Atomic Energy Community) Research and Training Programme, and future civil nuclear research in the UK.

<u>Guidance: State aid if there's no</u> <u>Brexit deal</u>

Find out how state aid givers and beneficiaries will be affected if the UK leaves the EU in March 2019 with 'no deal'.
