Extra-EU trade in goods by invoicing currency — Euro was the most used currency for EU exports and US dollars for EU imports in 2018

Goods imported and exported by the <u>European Union (EU)</u> can be invoiced in a range of currencies. In 2018, the euro was the most used currency for EU exports with a share of 48% of the total value of goods exported to non-EU countries and a share of 35% invoiced in US dollars. The picture was reversed for imports, with 56% of imports paid in US dollars and around a third in euros (35%). For total trade (exports plus imports) the US dollar (45%) was used slightly more often than the euro (41%).
