<u>February 2017-Euro area international</u> <u>trade in goods surplus €17.8 bn-€1.7</u> <u>bn surplus for EU28</u>

The first estimate for **euro area** (EA19) exports of goods to the rest of the world in February 2017 was $\in 170.3$ billion, an increase of 4% compared with February 2016 ($\in 163.2$ bn). Imports from the rest of the world stood at $\in 152.6$ bn, a rise of 5% compared with February 2016 ($\in 144.9$ bn). As a result, the **euro area** recorded a $\in 17.8$ bn surplus in trade in goods with the rest of the world in February 2017, compared with $+ \in 18.2$ bn in February 2016. **Intra-euro area** trade rose to $\in 149.1$ bn in February 2017, up by 5% compared with February 2016.
