Film Archive to present free screening of "Sun, Moon and Star"

Regarded as an epic literary work, the story tells of the three memorable tales of love of the male lead (Chang Yang) with the three female leads Julie Yeh Feng ("Sun"), Grace Chang ("Moon") and Lucilla You Min ("Star"). The films are in Mandarin without subtitles.
