## Government proposes to improve Sam Mun Tsai Village Pier

The Government intends to carry out improvement works at Sam Mun Tsai Village Pier within an area of approximately 1.66 hectares of foreshore and seabed to the west of Sam Mun Tsai. The extent of the area of foreshore and seabed affected is described in a <a href="mailto:notice">notice</a> gazetted today (April 1).

The proposed works will enhance the safety of pier users while boarding and alighting. During the construction stage, a temporary pier will be provided at the site for public use. The proposed works are scheduled to commence in mid-2022 for completion in mid-2024.

The notice and its related plan are posted near the site. The plan is also available for inspection at:

Any person who considers that he or she has an interest, right or easement in or over the foreshore and seabed involved may submit a written objection to the Director of Lands, 20/F, North Point Government Offices, 333 Java Road, North Point, Hong Kong, within two months from the above-mentioned date, i.e. on or before June 1. The notice of such an objection shall describe the interest, right or easement of the objector and the manner in which he or she will be allegedly affected.
