

Guidance: Energy Entrepreneurs Fund: phase 7

Updated: Applications have now closed.

Applications and expressions of interest have now closed.

Phase 7 of the Energy Entrepreneurs Fund, a competitive funding scheme to support the development and demonstration of state of the art technologies, products and processes in the areas of energy efficiency, power generation, and heat and electricity storage, is now open for applications.

The Energy Entrepreneurs Fund seeks the best ideas, irrespective of source, across these energy technology areas from the public and private sector. The scheme particularly aims to assist small and medium-sized enterprises, including start-ups, and those companies that are selected will receive additional funding for incubation support.

A total of £10 million is available for projects in phase 7, with up to £1 million available for projects up to £250,000.
