The Hong Kong Economic and Trade Office, Brussels (HKETO, Brussels), together with Invest Hong Kong (InvestHK) and the Hong Kong Trade Development Council (HKTDC), joined the South Summit held on October 2 to 4 (Madrid time) in Madrid, Spain.

Speaking as one of the panellists of a session on "Clues on how to do business in Asia", Deputy Representative of HKETO, Brussels, Mr Sam Hui, said that the free and open trade regime, business-friendly culture, rule of law, and good connectivity has enabled Hong Kong to grow into one of the major start-up hubs in the region.
