

Hong Kong Economic and Trade Office in Geneva celebrates 27th anniversary of establishment of HKSAR (with photos)

The Hong Kong Economic and Trade Office in Geneva hosted a reception on June 26 (Geneva time) to celebrate the 27th anniversary of the establishment of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region (HKSAR) with over 150 guests from diplomatic missions to the World Trade Organization (WTO), and key contacts in various international organisations, the academia and local businesses.

Hong Kong is a founding member of the WTO. Under the "one country, two systems" principle, Hong Kong maintains its separate WTO membership and participates as a separate customs territory in the name of Hong Kong, China.

Speaking at the reception, the Permanent Representative of the HKSAR of China to the WTO, Miss Winky So, highlighted Hong Kong's steadfast belief in free trade and its staunch support for the multilateral trading system with the WTO at its core.
