

Hong Kong Police's National Security Department executed National Security Law's search warrant to conduct search operation at a media company

The National Security Department of the Hong Kong Police this morning (June 17) conducted a search operation at a media company in Tseung Kwan O with a warrant issued under Article 43(1) of the Law of the People's Republic of China on Safeguarding National Security in the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region (National Security Law) and Schedule 1 of the Implementation Rules, covering the power of searching and seizure of journalistic materials.

The operation, still on-going, aims at gathering evidence for a case of suspected contravention of the National Security Law.
