

Hospital Authority announces senior appointment (with photo)

The Hospital Authority (HA) spokesperson announced the following senior appointment today (June 24):

Dr Ian Cheung will be appointed as Hospital Chief Executive (HCE) of Yan Chai Hospital with effect from August 2, succeeding Dr Ching Wai-kuen, who has taken up the post of HCE of Cheshire Home, Chung Hom Kok, Ruttonjee & Tang Shiu Kin Hospitals and Tung Wah Eastern Hospital.

Dr Cheung is a specialist in emergency medicine. He has worked in various departments in the HA Head Office since 2006.
