

Hospital Authority announces staff members confirmed or preliminarily confirmed as COVID-19 cases

The following is issued on behalf of the Hospital Authority:

The Hospital Authority (HA) today (February 14) announced that the following staff members in public hospitals and clinics are confirmed or preliminarily confirmed as having COVID-19 infection:

The hospitals and clinics concerned have conducted contact tracing as required and arranged cleaning for disinfection. All related staff members

had worn appropriate personal protective equipment at work. No patient has been identified as a close contact so far. Since some of the above-mentioned staff members had been eating or chatting, etc, with other staff members without wearing masks, 28 staff members have been identified as close contacts. Arrangements will be made for them to be quarantined and tested as required.

In light of the deteriorating epidemic situation, the HA again reminds its staff to minimise social activities and avoid having meals with other staff members. Staff members should also wear appropriate personal protective equipment at work.
