As part of the ongoing efforts to improve India's ranking in the Doing Business Report 2021, The Ministry of Labour & Employment has completed the reform to "Integrate process of registration for GST, EPFO, ESIC and Profession Tax for Maharashtra with company incorporation" in tandem with the MCA.

The reform has been completed by making the registration of new Public, Private Limited Companies and One Person Company for ESIC and EPFO mandatory through the Spice+ and AGILE-PRO eforms of MCA w.e.f.

CBDT issues FAQs on Direct Tax Vivad se Vishwas Scheme, 2020

The 'Vivad se Vishwas' Scheme was announced during the Union Budget, 2020, to provide for dispute resolution in respect of pending income tax litigation. Pursuant to the Budget announcement, the Direct Tax Vivad se Vishwas Bill, 2020 (hereinafter called Vivad se Vishwas) was introduced in the Lok Sabha on 5th of February, 2020 and passed by it on 4th of March, 2020.
