<u>Visit of admiral Tin Aung San,</u> <u>Commander in Chief, Myanmar Navy to</u> India

Admiral Tin Aung San, Commander-in-Chief, Myanmar Navy, is currently on a visit to India from 18 to 21 September 2017.
