Government clarifies that accommodation in any hotel, including 5-star hotels, having a declared tariff of a unit of accommodation of

less than INR 7500 per unit per day, will attract GST @ 18% ; Star rating of hotels is, therefore, irrelevant for determining the applicable rate of GST.

Reports have been received expressing doubts whether 5-star Hotels are liable to pay GST @ 28% irrespective of the declared tariff of a unit of accommodation.

Depression over Northwest & adjoining West-Central Bay of Bengal and coastal areas of Odisha & North Andhra Pradesh

The depression over northwest and adjoining West-Central Bay of Bengal & coastal areas of Odisha remained practically stationary in past 3 hours and lay centred at 1130 hrs IST of today, the 18 th July, 2017 near latitude 19.0° N and longitude 86.0 °E, about 120 km east-southeast of Gopalpur and 80 km south-southeast of Puri.
