January 2018-Euro area international trade in goods surplus €3.3 bn-€20.3 bn deficit for EU28

The first estimate for **euro area** (EA19) exports of goods to the rest of the world in January 2018 was $\[\in \]$ 178.6 billion, an increase of 9.1% compared with January 2017 ($\[\in \]$ 163.7 bn). Imports from the rest of the world stood at $\[\in \]$ 175.4 bn, a rise of 6.3% compared with January 2017 ($\[\in \]$ 165.0 bn). As a result, the **euro area** recorded a $\[\in \]$ 3.3 bn surplus in trade in goods with the rest of the world in January 2018, compared with a deficit of $\[\in \]$ 1.4 bn in January 2017. **Intra-euro area** trade rose to $\[\in \]$ 159.8 bn in January 2018, up by 8.8% compared with January 2017.
