## <u>July 2018 — Euro area international</u> <u>trade in goods surplus €17.6 bn — €0.1</u> <u>bn surplus for EU28</u>

The first estimate for **euro area** (EA19) exports of goods to the rest of the world in July 2018 was  $\[ \in \]$ 194.6 billion, an increase of 9.4% compared with July 2017 ( $\[ \in \]$ 177.8 bn). Imports from the rest of the world stood at  $\[ \in \]$ 177.1 bn, a rise of 13.4% compared with July 2017 ( $\[ \in \]$ 156.2 bn). As a result, the **euro area** recorded a  $\[ \in \]$ 17.6 bn surplus in trade in goods with the rest of the world in July 2018, compared with  $\[ \in \]$ 21.6 bn in July 2017. **Intra-euro area** trade rose to  $\[ \in \]$ 162.3 bn in July 2018, up by 9.3% compared with July 2017.
