Hong Kong's table tennis athletes Lee Ho-ching, Doo Hoi-kem, Soo Wai-yam and Zhu Chengzhu today (August 5) added a bronze medal to the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region's tally by winning the Table Tennis Women's Team competition at the Tokyo 2020 Olympic Games.
