The Legislative Council (LegCo) Panel on Commerce and Industry visited the Hong Kong Science Park (HKSP) today (February 23) to better understand the work of HKSP and its development plans.

Accompanied by the Permanent Secretary for Innovation and Technology, Ms Annie Choi, the Under Secretary for Innovation and Technology, Dr David Chung, and the Chairman of the Hong Kong Science and Technology Parks Corporation (HKSTPC), Dr Sunny Chai, Members received a briefing by representatives of HKSTPC on Hong Kong's innovation and technology ecosystem and future development of HKSTPC.
