LegCo Panel on Development to conduct study visit to Shanghai

The Legislative Council (LegCo) Panel on Development will depart for Shanghai tomorrow (December 19) to conduct a three-day study visit.

- Xuhui Riverside Development Area; and
- Zhang Yuan.

The delegation is led by the Chairman of the Panel on Development, Mr Tony Tse. Deputy delegation leader is the Deputy Chairman of the Panel, Mr Lau Kwok-fan.
