

Life beyond finishing line

The Culture, Sports and Tourism Bureau's Retired Athletes Transformation Programme has so far helped over 140 athletes transition to new careers after they stop competing. The Government also offers comprehensive support to current athletes through various scholarship programmes, allowing them to plan ahead early.
