If you have been injured in this incident you can apply to the Criminal Injuries Compensation Authority (CICA) for compensation.

Compensation is payable to applicants who meet the eligibility criteria of the <u>Criminal Injuries Compensation Scheme 2012.</u>

You don't need a paid representative, such as a solicitor or claims management company, to apply for compensation. Free independent advice may be available from the <u>Victim and Witness Information</u> website or other charitable organisations.
