Local soprano Athene Mok to give recital in October

She has taken part in a number of opera performances including the main character, the Ghost, in the contemporary chamber opera "Ghost Love", Poppea and Valletto in "L'incoronazione di Poppea", Morgana in "Alcina" and Despina in "Cosi fan Tutte". Being an active concert soloist, she has also collaborated with the Rochester Philharmonic Orchestra, the Eastman Philharmonia and Eastman Rochester Chorus as well as the Bucknell University Choir and Camerata.
