London ETO promotes Hong Kong films at London East Asia Film Festival 2020 (with photos)

The HKSAR Government is also committed to providing multi-pronged support for the Hong Kong film industry to go through this unprecedented time. Announced earlier in July 2020, around HK\$260 million (GBP\$26 million) has been embarked under the Film Development Fund to increase local film productions and nurture young talents. We look forward to bringing more Hong Kong films to the UK audiences."
