## May 2018 — Euro area international trade in goods surplus €16.5 bn — €0.2 bn surplus for EU28

The first estimate for **euro area** (EA19) exports of goods to the rest of the world in May 2018 was  $\le$ 189.6 billion, a decrease of 0.8% compared with May 2017 ( $\le$ 191.2 bn). Imports from the rest of the world stood at  $\le$ 173.1 bn, a rise of 0.7% compared with May 2017 ( $\le$ 171.9 bn). As a result, the **euro area** recorded a  $\le$ 16.5 bn surplus in trade in goods with the rest of the world in May 2018, compared with  $+ \le$ 19.3 bn in May 2017. **Intra-euro area** trade rose to  $\le$ 162.3 bn in May 2018, up by 0.5% compared with May 2017.
