
<u>Sister of Iran's supreme leader</u> <u>denounces 'tyranny' of regime</u>

LONDON: Badri Hosseini Khamenei, the sister of Iran's supreme leader, said on Wednesday that she soon hopes to see the overthrow of her brother's "tyranny," adding that he "has brought nothing but suffering and oppression" to his people.

Khamenei's family have been fierce critics of the Islamic regime since 1979, after the revolution deposed the last shah of Iran, Mohammad Reza Pahlavi.

BEIRUT: The Free Patriotic Movement's anger over caretaker Prime Minister

Najib Mikati convening a Cabinet session on Monday led to a shakeup in the relationship between the party and its ally, Hezbollah.

Hezbollah and the Amal Movement provided political cover for Mikati to convene a Cabinet session to approve the process of securing medicines for dialysis and cancer patients, which Mikati deems an absolute necessity.


Jordanian, Egyptian and Iraqi foreign ministers discuss opportunities for trilateral cooperation

AMMAN: The foreign ministers of Jordan, Egypt and Iraq, Ayman Safadi, Sameh Shoukry and Fuad Hussein, met on Wednesday to discuss ways in which the strategic integration of their countries might be boosted through a trilateral cooperation mechanism, the Jordan News Agency reported.

Five protesters sentenced to death by Iran regime

JEDDAH: Iran's regime on Tuesday sentenced five people to death for allegedly killing a member of a paramilitary force affiliated with Iran's Islamic Revolutionary Guard. Eleven others received prison sentences.

The 13 men and three minors had been charged with killing Ruhollah Ajamian, a member of the Basij, a paramilitary volunteer branch of Iran's elite Revolutionary Guard.

<u>Usufruct rights granted for Egypt's</u> natural reserves to boost ecotourism

CAIRO: In a significant move, Egypt's government has granted usufruct rights to investors to expand ecotourism in nature reserves for up to 10 years, provided that the local population is employed in the projects involved.
